

Health

This district has a well-established Health directorate. The directorate manages Nine (9) administrative Sub-districts, 45 health facilities comprising one district hospital, 7 health centers, 2 clinics and 35 CHPS zones. These facilities serve approximately 72 health communities in the district. On the part of the 35 demarcated CHPS zones, these facilities are all functional with support of GoG, donors and local stakeholders. In all, 144 community volunteers are supporting in health service delivery in these facilities.

The main issues in the goal of the Directorate is to become the lead in the assemblies of region with universal and sustainable health coverage for all persons, so that it can attain the highest standards of health and development by the year 2030 in terms of maternal and child health service delivery.

What this means and by sub objectives is to ensure:

- ✓ A healthy population to be able to do productive activities and reducing health issues that have implications on pressure on health personnel, facilities and government
- ✓ Engage in health education on illnesses such as HIV/AIDS, COVID 19 and many terminal sicknesses
- ✓ Promote hygiene activities such as Hand Washing With Soap (HWWS) under running water
- ✓ Promote with collaboration with the EHSU to sensitize communities on bad practices on Open Defecation.

Apart from these, there are about thirty-five (35) Community Health Planning Services (CHPS) serving communities in the district. Although these are available in the district, the facilities are in categories based on their functionalities. For instance, there are some that are one for outreach purposes. This means, health officers only go to these communities to hold health related activities and return to base. These facilities have no accommodation as well as a facility to conduct health screen and services. Under this category, 13 are functional with 1 in Namolgo-Kpatia in Sawaliga/Buugu community under construction
